New Features for Certified Medical Examiners Identifying Late Exams

The FMCSA Medical Programs Division thanks you for your continued partnership and for the critical role you play in the National Registry of Certified Medical Examiners. We have carefully reviewed your feedback and are introducing several improvements to help you more easily navigate the system. The planned improvements will address issues regarding late exam notifications and navigating various system functions.

What is Changing?

We have included several updates to the Medical Examiner's (ME) National Registry account dashboard and exam report.

When will this change take affect?

This change will be deployed by 10pm EDT on 9/18/2025.

How will this Change Affect You?

These updates have been designed to help you, as an ME, address notifications that one or more exams submitted late by you, or a Medical Examiner's Administrative Assistant (MEAA) or Third-Party Organization (TPO) on your behalf. For example, you will be able to easily identify which exams you, an MEAA, or TPO have not submitted to the National Registry in accordance with the regulatory requirement. You will be able to confirm the details of a late exam notification and determine effective strategies to ensure future on-time exam submissions. Once this change has been deployed, it will be available to you upon logging into your National Registry account.

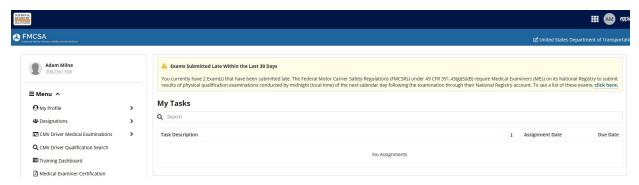

Medical Examiner's Dashboard and Exam Report Updates 9/18/2025

NOTE: This document serves as a quick reference guide to navigating update. Because the document was written prior to deployment, actual screenshots might vary from what is deployed. The ME User Manual will be updated with finalized screenshots and functionality descriptions two weeks after deployment.

1. Dashboard Changes

When you log into the National Registry, you will be taken to your dashboard. If you have at least one Medical Exam that was submitted late by you, or on your behalf, in the last 30 days, you will see a banner above the My Tasks section, as shown below.



The banner will contain a link to the CMV Driver Medical Examination Search, auto-filtered, which will let you easily locate late Exams. It will automatically disappear from your dashboard once the NR confirms that no late Exams have been submitted in the past 30 days.

2. Exam Report Changes

To search for and view results of Medical Exams submitted by you or on your behalf, use the Exam Report as described below.

NOTE: In this section, "Exams" will pertain to any CMV Medical Exams submitted by you or on your behalf.

1. From your dashboard, select CMV Driver Medical Examinations.



2. Select Search.

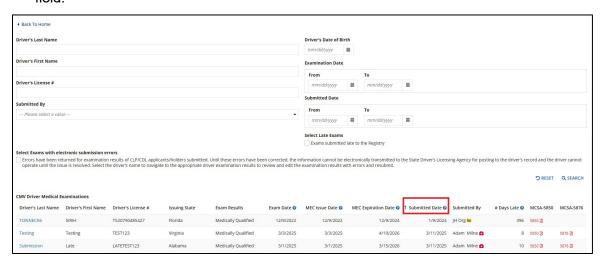


NOTE: Exams will not be displayed until AFTER filtering information has been entered.

3. If you select **SEARCH** without entering any filters, a list of all Exams will be provided.



4. The search results will include a new **Submitted Date** field, so that you can see when exams were submitted. This date can be sorted by clicking on the field's header and can be used to determine which exams were submitted late, by comparing with the **Exam Date** field



5. Icons next to each Submitted By entry denote the role of the person who submitted the Exam (e.g., ME, Medical Exam Administrative Assistant [MEAA], or Third Party Organization [TPO]). Use these icons to better distinguish any exams that were not submitted by you.



- 6. You can use the search parameters provided, to filter the results by entering information into the desired filter(s). New filters added to the report include:
 - a. Submitted Date use this to find Exams submitted on a specific date
 - b. **Submitted By** use this to find Exams submitted by a specific Submitter role (ME, MEAA, or TPO).
 - c. **Select Late Exams** to only show late Exams on the report, select the "Select Late Exams" checkbox.



7. New helper text has been added to the Date fields on the report, to help clarify the meaning of these fields. To view helper text for a field, hover over the blue question mark next to the field
